You don't have to choose between performance OR comfort with the Balance 451 - this boat has all that and more! Rendezvous was designed and custom fitted for speed, with a large rig, top quality mainsail, screecher, jib, spinnaker and dagger boards.

The state of the art LiFePO4 battery system is light and provides ample power for all your needs A/C, microwave, induction cooktop, coffee maker, etc. A custom solar array has been added for complete off grid capability.

You'll find ample storage throughout the boat for long passages and off-the-grid living. Anchor with confidence with an Lewmar CPX3 electric windlass, G4 stainless steel anchor chain and a Rocna 33Kg anchor.

Premium Raymarine navigation and monitoring systems keep you informed and on the right course. The Raymarine auto-pilot has been upgraded from the standard model to the ACU-400 for more robust performance.

Even at first glance, you get a sense this boat is truly different - wave-piercing bows, aero dynamic sloped windows, carbon fiber bowsprit and retractable dagger boards. Stunning!

If you are looking for a blue water cruising catamaran that can get you where you want to go fast - you've found it!
